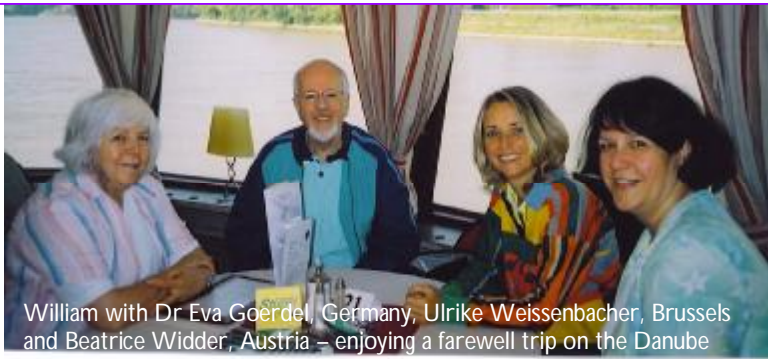

William's farewells to those on EU mainland (continued from page 1)

My work in Service began early in 1970 under the guidance of Frank and Doris Jones, in Bexhill-on-Sea. In 1975 I started 8 years of training at The College of Psychotherapeutics near Tunbridge Wells with Ronald Beesley, Peter Goldman, Cicely and Jack Allan and others. That property was sold in 2005. The College is now called the Centre of New Directions (see Link 18). In 1983 I started work part-time on EU mainland, and on 1.1.85, full-time. So much has led on from those preparatory days.

On page 1, I have spoken of the work in Vienna, which became the main centre of my final work abroad. However, I owe a great debt to many, many other people over the 23 year period of my work in Austria, Germany and Switzerland, too many to mention by name, but deeply embedded in the nature of my being. You have brought me to where I am. At our highest point, we had 2000 names and addresses; some have moved on; but some 75% are still with us. My thanks to everyone.

What is very noticeable, now that this change has been made, is that whilst the current students have been handed over to my successors, many people from 20 and more years ago are contacting me again – remarkable support from the 'upstairs management'! Very heartening.....

With Beatrice's move to Graz in April 2004, that became the main centre, with Vienna becoming the subsidiary. Many years of work in Graz had previously been organised by Inge Krasser-Mozer, followed by Helene Dietze and Maria Maier. Much work was also done in Linz, organised mainly by Gertrude Morzinger. The early work in Germany was near Munich, but mainly in Augsburg, where Christa Schuierer was organiser for 10 years, taking over the work from Emmi and Julian Webb. From there, organised by Delf and Edith Banz, courses were taught near Stuttgart, plus near Hannover with Dr. Marie-Luisa Kohl. Several years of work was done near Aurau, Switzerland, organised by Gisela and Bernd Sitte. Altogether, work was done in other places, with other organisers, too many to mention here. My thanks to them all for their support and generous hospitality from the many homes I stayed in. Without them, the work would have been much more difficult. Beatrice now continues to expand upon these contacts and places of work, with newer organisers and helpers.

In UK, changes and delegation are also taking place, through Angela Savage and others. My thanks also to those dear friends in the higher worlds who co-ordinate closely with us and lead us ever onwards into new challenges, to bring out our full potential, as we face the unknown future of the Earth and whole Cosmos.

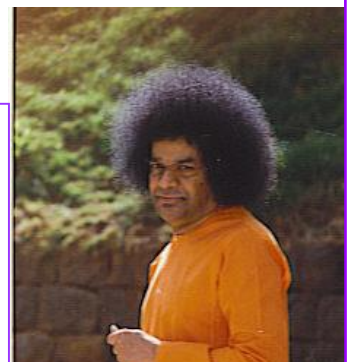
