UNDERSTANDING THE ATMA OR "I AM" TRUE SELF

At present, our body is undoubtedly the centre of our whole universe. We associate it, without thinking, with our self and our ego, and this thoughtless and false association continually reinforces our illusion of their inseparable, concrete existence. Because our body seems so convincingly to exist, our "I" seems to exist, and "you" seem to exist, and the entire illusory, dualistic world we never stop projecting around us looks ultimately solid and real.

Develop constant awareness of the Atma;
It is only the body that dies; the Atma is eternal and changeless.*

When you dive deep into a problem and *enquire from your heart* whether your proposed action is good for your society, your conscience shall give you the right answer. All actions must be pre-examined as to whether they will lead to good or bad results. When discrimination is not exercised, the mind becomes blind. It is the Atma that activates the mind and illuminates the intelligence.

You are not one person but three:

Body: the one you think you are (physical, servant, messenger);
Mind: the one others think you are (your personality, character, knowledge)
Spirit: and the one you really are ("I and my Father are One", True Self, I am, Atma)
Man has three identities – physical, mental and spiritual.

His spiritual identity indicates man's oneness with God.

In the same way, Hanuman said to Rama:

"Oh Lord! At the physical level I am Your servant;
at the mental level I am a part of You;
and at the Atmic level, You and I are one."

Every human being needs to think in this manner. Firstly, he needs to consider himself as a messenger of God, taking the path of Karma or work to serve God wholeheartedly, engaging in actions which are good and noble. This is the path of spirituality. It includes serving, singing, chanting and penance. The path of knowledge which leads to wisdom is the ultimate path.

The three 'W's denote Work, Worship and Wisdom. Wisdom is the ultimate goal.

God is present everywhere. He is not limited to a particular place, church, or centre. He is in you, with you, above you, below you and around you.

He will become visible when we make proper efforts.

Listen, maintain silence and be quiet; talk only as much as is necessary.

Show reverence to your elders, parents, teachers; treat them with humility and courtesy.

Develop love; love in man is the special grace which God bestows upon him.

Love is God, God is Love.

Meditate on the heart centre. Know Thyself! Surrender!

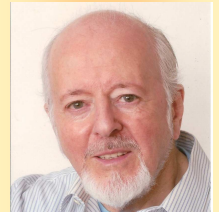

SYNCHRONICITY

By asking, or even having the thought that we need an answer, we are giving those who serve the Cosmic Presence permission to inspire us. To intervene, they need our karmic consent. The more you meditate, the quicker will be the answers from the loving souls who serve in the higher regions and who are waiting to be helpful to us in our sometimes chaotic and frustrating journey through our life on earth. **However, always remember that challenges come to bring out the best in us, to release our full potential.** (William)
